

### INTRODUCTION

The SEAS 9000 TV Portal is easy and intuitive to use. The Menu is easily operated by your Samsung Smart TV remote control, Arris Set-top-box remote control, or from your mobile device touch screen.

On the right side is an example of what the main menu can look like.

The headlines differ from portal to portal depending on which features the specific portal has.



### OPERATING THE MENU FROM YOUR REMOTE CONTROL

Use the Samsung TV or Set-Top-Box Remote Contol to easily operate the Menu.



Navigate the Menu using the arrows:



Click the "Enter" button in the middle to select a chosen element.



Click "Back" in the buttom left corner to go back one step in the Menu.





### OPERATING THE MENU FROM YOUR MOBILE DEVICE

As with all other apps you "tap" your touch screen to select which menus to move between. See picture 1-3. You go back tapping the blue menu icon. See picture 3.



1. Tap "Movies"

2. Tap on a movie

3. Tap blue menu to go back

### **HOME SCREEN**

This is the screen you come to when you first turn ON the Television.

#### TV CHANNELS

When selecting "TV Channels" a list of available TV channels is shown. If EGP data is available for the channel a program guide will automatically be shown. In case there is no EPG data the program guide will be empty.

## VIDEO-ON-DEMAND (Requires VOD Software Package)

If the TV Portal is installed with Video-On-Demand and has a movie library, all movies can be accessed from this menu. It is possible to search movies by different genres. When watching a movie use the menu to rewind, fast forward, pause or play at any time.

## RECORDINGS (Requires TV-O-D Software Package)

Simply operate the menu to select the program (requires EPG data) or select the specific time slot i.e. 9-10 (requires no EPG), which should be recorded. All previous recordings are also shown and accessed from this menu.

## MESSAGES (Requires Infotainment Software Package)

New and previous messages are shown in this menu. It is also possible to receive realtime popup messages directly on the television from the "message adminstrator".
